

Thank you for your recent enquiry relating to Green issues, and please accept my apology for the brevity of this reply.

Alan Mosley has, I'm pleased to see, comprehensively encompassed the views of myself and other Labour candidates in his detailed reply.

Bayston Hill Parish Council (of which I am a member) have made various practical responses to the serious environmental issues facing us all. We are in process of completing our three year project to create a 6 acre area of new woodland, including a community orchard, at Lythwood. We have recreated sizeable area of water (on site of former fish pools for the local hall) at Parr's Pool, including a half mile circular path around the pool and adjacent woodland, specifically designed for wheel chair access. And our local hall has recently installed a wind turbine to generate electricity for the very well used building.

I hope this very brief response is helpful and invite you to perhaps visit Bayston Hill and take a look at our efforts todate . . .
